1NT OPENER

- 15-17 balanced, may have 5cd suit. If a major, it will usually be a good suit. Good suits can play well in NT. Crappy suits have more strength as trumps.
- Rarely, may have singleton in certain cases: where singleton suit is "above" the biddable 4- or 5-card suits (eg., 1444, 3145). Best if singleton is honor.Otherwise, open 1 of suit.

RESPONSE SCENARIOS

Responder's options:

- Stayman promises 4-card major, 9hcp (in case opener has 17HCP opener and drives to game). May be 5-4 in majors see "Stayman convention" below.

 Because 2N is not invitational, 2C may also be an 8-9 balanced hand with no 4-card major.
- 2D Transfer, promises 5cd Hearts
- 2H Transfer, promises 5cd Spades
- 2S Minor suit stayman, promises 10hcp, 5-4 in minors with mild slam interest Opener bids
 - 2N no 4-cd minor, both majors stopped
 - 3C/D lowest 4cd minor

Garbage Stayman

For weak hands with no 5-card major to transfer into (might use garbage if 4-5). If you have Diamonds and Opener responds 2D to 2C, you drop there.

If you don't have Diamonds, you must have both majors, because you need tocorrect if Opener bids 2D.

If 4-5 in majors, bid Hearts over 2D, then Opener can correct to Spades ifneeded.

Or Opener can bid 3C if has not-too-common 2-2-4-5 distribution.
